About Us

Lilian Baylis, Lambeth, is a flagship secondary school offering students the opportunity to excel in all areas of school life, academically and socially. In 2005 the school relocated to Kennington Road, offering a full range of A-levels and BTECs. To ensure all its students become “healthy, confident and independent thinking adults” Lilian Baylis has worked tirelessly to develop teaching programmes that provide support and encouragement.

Previously we have welcomed speakers including then **Prime Minister Tony Blair** (2005) and **Prime Minister Gordon Brown** when we opened our sixth form.



We provide a diverse range of subjects, excellent educational facilities and supportive and stimulating environments, confirmed in a recent Ofsted inspection, which graded the school “**outstanding in all areas**”. The report

by Ofsted details how the school has been graded as “**outstanding for achievement, teaching, behaviour and leadership with exemplary features**” which no other secondary school in Lambeth and only two schools in London have achieved since the new Ofsted inspection process introduced in September 2012.

Our Speaker Programme

Lilian Baylis stresses the importance of a well structured curriculum that nurtures the development of all its students’ “self confidence and identity.” We welcome Guest Speakers to address our students. Our Speaker Programme hopes to include individuals who will entertain,

inform and challenge our students in a range of subjects outside the mainstream curriculum.

By discussing a range of subjects, the programme raises awareness of issues previously unexplored by our students. The programme also encourages them to think independently and speak out and engage with others to develop their interactive skills and confidence.

The programme’s inaugural speaker, Crossbench Peer **Professor Lord Alton of Liverpool**,



addressed the sixth form on March 13th 2013, speaking about his career in politics, as the youngest MP to enter the House of Commons in 1979, and his work campaigning for Human Rights.

Lord Alton challenged students to think about the changes they could bring about in themselves, their communities, the UK and the world. He concluded that meaningful action should be taken at all levels.

Other speakers have included **Rob Ffello MP**, Labour’s Youth Justice Spokesperson; **Baroness Sheila Hollins**, President of the British Medical Association; **Paul Maynard MP** and **Lord Michael Hastings**, Global Head of Corporate Social Responsibility for KPMG.

Our Speaker Programme encourages independent thinking, open discussion and personal growth. We are seeking speakers who will engage our students, relay personal experiences, discuss their interests, provide a forum for open discussion, and most importantly, challenge their thinking on a wide range of subjects.
